PROGRAM INFORMATION

Teens In Leadership Training (T.I.L.T.) is a program for teens in sixth grade and up that focuses on communication, team building, leadership skills, discipleship and fellowship. They generally meet every other month on Sundays, at 12:30 p.m. in Room C-12 (check the church calendar for details). All teens that are currently serving or planning to serve in the Children's Ministry are required to attend TILT meetings.

In order serve in the Children's Ministry at Calvary Chapel St. Petersburg, teens must complete the following basics:

The Basics: (Required)

1. Complete and Sign a Children's Ministry application.
2. Read and sign the T.I.L.T. commitment form.
3. Attend the mandatory Children's Ministry Orientation meeting.
4. Attend on a regular basis an accountability group and a corporate service once per week.
5. Attend the Children's Ministry Training and the Children's Ministry Conference when offered.
6. Attend T.I.L.T. meetings— generally, meetings will be held on the first Sunday every other month at 12:30-2 p.m. Check for information on the church website.

To Graduate: (Optional)

1. Complete the following training sessions:

A. Leading a Child to Christ	E. Crafts
B. Effective Teaching (Nursery, Pre-K or Elementary sessions)	F. Games
C. Discipline in the classroom	G. Memorizing Scripture
D. Orderly Classroom	H. Children's Worship
	I. Inductive Bible Study
2. Serve in the Children's Ministry in a classroom for a minimum of one six-month session with an adult teacher
3. Prepare and teach a class on their own for one week under the supervision of an adult.
