Executive Vice-President for  
PIONEERS-USA



Ted Esler, Executive Vice-President for PIONEERS-USA, is author of *Overwhelming Minority*. Ted and his wife, Annette, moved to Sarajevo, Bosnia to serve as missionaries shortly after the Dayton Peace Accord was signed in 1992. During the next seven years, their team also established works in Zenica and Novi Travnik. Under Ted's leadership, the PIONEERS Bosnia Team grew to about 22 adults with more than 25 children. Ted then served as the director of PIONEERS-CANADA before joining the Executive Team of PIONEERS-USA. Ted is currently in a doctoral studies program at Fuller School of Intercultural Studies. The Eslers have five children: Caleb, Joshua, David, Sarah, and Abigail.



**Sujo John**

Sujo John was launched into an international evangelistic ministry following the tragic attacks of September 11, 2001. Six months previous to the terrorist attacks on the two world trade towers in New York City, Sujo and his wife Mary had moved from India seeking adventure and prosperity in the United States. Sujo worked on the 81st floor of Tower 1, and his wife Mary worked in Tower 2. By the grace of God, they both survived to tell of their accounts of those horrific events. News channels and countless other publications from all over the world have taken interest in their story. In those early days following the terrorist attacks, God began unleashing a burden on Sujo's heart to share Christ with people around the world. He and his wife Mary and their children, Jeremy and Sophia, reside in Lantana, TX.

David Nelson spent 14 years church planting in the Philippines, planting two churches in Bohol. He was the Asian Coordinator at Bible Training Centre for Pastors in the Philippines. He currently trains pastors throughout the world through the ministry that he started called Crossing Cultures International.
