1. “Who is God?” → A quest to live in the knowledge of God through Christ

Philippians 3:10 - that I may know him and the power of °his resurrection, and °may share his sufferings, °becoming like him in his death

2. “Who am I!” → A quest to live from the core of new life in Christ

2 Corinthians 5:17 - Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.”

3. “Why am I here?” → A quest to live for the purposes of Christ in this world.

2 Timothy 4:7 - I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.

Conclusion:

Acts 9:10 – “Behold, he prays.”
