
The Queen Bee

• Who is in control of everything? God is in control of everything in heaven and on earth.


FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:






STORY POINT: GOD MADE ESTHER A QUEEN TO PROTECT HIS PEOPLE.

- What does Jesus protect us from?


FAMILY ACTIVITY:

• Who is in control of everything? God is in control of everything in heaven and on earth.


FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:






STORY POINT: GOD'S PEOPLE REPENTED AND PROMISED TO BE FAITHFUL.

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- Why do we offer our best to God?
- How did God offer His best to us?
- Who was the messenger Malachi said would come before Jesus?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

• Take turns with your family naming chores or daily tasks. Then discuss what would happen if you only did that task halfway, such as only driving halfway to school, only halfway washing dishes, or doing half a project. Remind your kids that Jesus gave His all for us.
