## CALVARY CHAPEL ST. PETERSBURG FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE GUIDELINES

"Blessed is the man who perseveres under trial, because when he has stood the test, he will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love Him."

James 1:12

The primary focus of the Special Needs Ministry is to minister to members within our own fellowship who are facing a financial emergency or experiencing a hardship which interferes with meeting their basic family needs. The Special Needs fund is not intended for meeting long-term financial needs. Requests will be prayerfully considered using the guidelines below. Please read the following carefully so you will understand the criteria we use to base our decisions. As soon as a determination has been made, someone from the church staff will contact you.

- 1. As a part of this body, we strongly recommend (if you are not already doing so) that you become involved in a home fellowship or small group, so that you may receive the support and strength that comes from fellowship with your brothers and sisters in Christ.
- 2. The focus of the benevolence ministry is assisting with basic needs, such as food and shelter.
- 3. It is never our purpose in providing benevolence to relieve the consequences of unrepented sin (Luke 15:16-17). Calvary Chapel looks to assist those people in need who are seeking to be obedient to the Lord's will.
- 4. Benevolence is given to assist the recipient as he or she works through the problem, not to bail an individual out of their situation. (Leviticus 19:9-10). Galatians 2:10 tells us to help the needy. 1 Timothy 5 tells us that we must discern who is really in need. 2 Thessalonians 3:10 says, "If anyone will not work, neither shall he eat."
- 5. In reference to widows in the church, Scripture is very clear in 1 Timothy 5:3-8, that financial assistance should first be sought from other family members before making a request to the church.
- 6. Calvary Chapel's response to a request will not be predicated upon the urgency of circumstances. Rather, any urgency will be prompted by the Holy Spirit. Requests for benevolence require pastoral review, which may take several days.
- 7. In some cases, applicants may be required to meet with a Calvary Chapel Financial Counselor before any benevolence is administered.
- 8. Applicants who ignore or do not follow through with suggested counsel may be denied their request.
- 9. All follow-up and follow through is the responsibility of the person submitting the request.
- 10. Any violation of honesty will disqualify a request.
- 11. All benevolence checks will be made payable to the debtor only, and never to the recipient of the financial aid (e.g. utility company, landlord, etc.).
- 12. Calvary Chapel's response to a request is considered to be confidential. A violation of confidentiality may result in disqualification of a request currently being considered and/or future requests.
- \* Also, any assistance given is not to be considered as a loan, however, as the Lord allows and enables you in the future, you might consider giving a gift to the Special Needs fund.
